- Ashe's Ferry marker - Repair and refurbish - \$1,485 + \$400 loading fee + \$805 loading prep (two trips)
= \$2690; New marker = \$2,930, delivered to Jim Brown Signs, but it does not have a dock or a forklift,
so an additional \$200 = \$3130 - **\$440 difference**
- King Haigler marker removed, stored and re-erected due to SCDOT roundabout construction 2027
